## CLASSIFICATION

1. It is important to note that new levels in the Classifications will be created as each Category attracts more participants
2. I-karate can be further classified by age, gender, belt or grade. A Category needs to have enough competitors for a competition to be viable. The minimum of 3. If less than 3 than these athletes will be put in the next higher category.
3. Our experience has shown that both I-Kata and I-Kumite need to be carried out one after the other for disabled people to minimise waiting time and also to reduce organisation time.
4. Complains can only be directed by the head coach at the table. If the table together with the comfort referee cannot reply than the organiser of the competition will be called and he will make the decision.
5. If the participant inscribe in a category, for example kumite and he doesn't know the drill that is necessary for this category, the athlete will be expelled by the head comfort referee appointed for the floor.
6. If the disabilities are too different in one category the kumite drill can be performed together and only with the head comfort referee, this will be decided on the day.
7. Extra points will be given if necessary and showed to the public and judges just before the match. Points will be spoken out by the head comfort referee.
8. Bad behaviour from competitors or visitors will not be tolerated, and you will be removed from the venue by the security.
